Williams Landing Neighbourhood Grants

The Williams Landing Neighbourhood Grants program was developed by Cedar Woods in recognition of the important role that community groups play in building healthy and vibrant neighbourhoods.

In 2011, up to \$20,000 will be allocated to community groups in grants of \$500, \$1,000 or \$2,000.

The program is funded by Cedar Woods through a percentage of sales from every lot sold.

Sporting, welfare, culture, recreation and other not-for-profit groups providing services that benefit the community are encouraged to apply.

Do I qualify?

- To be eligible to apply, community groups must be not-for-profit organisations and must have been in operation for more than 12 months.
- Groups must be located within or provide services to the suburbs of Hoppers Crossing, Point Cook, Seabrook, Altona Meadows, Truganina, Tarneit, Laverton, Werribee or Williams Landing.
- Only one application per group will be accepted per year.
- All applications will be reviewed by the Williams Landing Neighbourhood Grants committee and applicants will be advised of results in August 2011.

What can grants be used for?

Grants can be used for a range of needs including new equipment, uniforms, landscaping, building improvements and many more initiatives.
